



## BS4'S FOOTBALL HEARTBEAT SINCE 1957

The club was established in 1956 as an under-16 team, and initially played in the Bristol Church of England League, winning the Somerset Intermediate Cup in 1961–62 and 1962–63, and the Somerset Junior Cup in 1963–64. By 1965 the club were playing in the Senior Division of the Bristol & Suburban League.

During the 1970s we moved up to the Somerset County League, winning the League Cup in 1976–77, and finishing as runners-up in the Premier Division in 1979–80, 1983–84 and 1984–85.

The club went on to win the Premier Division and the Somerset Senior Cup in 1988–89, and after finishing as runners-up and winning the Senior Cup in 1990–91, they were promoted to Division One of the Western League.

Brislington won the Somerset Senior Cup again in 1992–93, and after a third-place finish in Division One in 1993–94, they won both Division One and the Senior Cup the following season and were promoted to the Premier Division. After winning the Somerset Premier Cup in 1995–96, the club were Premier Division runners-up in 2002–03 and again in 2012–13.

Due to the escalating travel costs of the Toolstation Western League Premier Division, which forced Odd Down to take voluntary relegation, and with a sideways move to the Hellenic Premier ruled out, the club decided to follow Odd Down's lead and take the step down to the Toolstation Western League Division one.

This proved to be a decisive move as the 2022/23 Season saw the Foxes win the league, scoring 130 goals in the process, and reach the Semi Final of the Les Phillips Cup.

Brislington were unable to return to the Premier Division, although this was a blessing in disguise as that season saw the demise of Ashton & Backwell as a Western league club and Bitton, who failed to fulfil their fixtures, pulling out midway through the season, both falling foul of the increased running costs.

The 2023/24 Season saw the reintroduction of an U18s side as the club look to rebuild a pathway to adult football from within. Unfortunately the season was plagued by poor weather, far too many games were cancelled due to persistent rain, leaving all three teams a far-from-ideal heavily-backloaded schedule. Despite that however, all three teams were to gain a level of success on the pitch.



The first team were promoted back to the Premier Division albeit via the play-offs, after finishing a very disappointing seventh in the table (despite finishing the league's leading goalscorers). However they redeemed themselves by beating Radstock Town away in the semi-final then Wincanton Town away 2-3, where a dramatic second-half comeback saw a two-goal first-half deficit overturned with the winner coming in the 93rd minute, curtesy of Lewis Dunn!!

They also reached the Final of the Somerset Senior Cup although that game wasn't played due to the backlog of league fixtures, both the semi-final and final were due to be played before July 31st 2024!

The reserve team made it to their cup Final. Unfortunately they would lose to opponents Haywood Village, missing out on penalties after the game couldn't be settled in 90 minutes.

The re-emergence of the U18s, lead by John Smallwood, Phil Wiltshire & John Lovell were a revelation, winning their league to gain promotion losing only one game in the process.

More importantly from a club perspective, 10 young players were to feature for the first team, unsurprisingly none looking out of place, with a few excelling, proving the decision to reintroduce an 18s set-up was a very good one.

The 2024/25 season saw Matt Lewton replace John Smallwood and challenge for the league which went down to the final games, eventually missing out, however they did win the Roger Stone Memorial Cup to cap a memorable two years for the group.

The first team were to finish comfortably mid table in their first season back in the Jewson Western Premier League. Unfortunately they would lose long standing manager (and now club legend) Lee Perks who retired from his first team management duties after 10 years at the helm and 18 years at the club as a player, reserve team manager, 1st team assistant manager and ultimately 1st team number one.

Lee is replaced By Ash Kington who will front the campaign for the upcoming season.



## BURLAND ATT - CLUB HISTORY

#### **Foundations (1977–1987)**

Formed in 1977 as a junior club playing in the Torbay Pioneer League, Buckland Athletic quickly grew into one of Devon's largest youth setups, lifting numerous local honours including the Devon Youth Cup.

## Stepping into Senior Football (1987–2000)

In 1987-88, manager Roy Holmes guided his under-18 side into the Devon & Exeter League and immediately won the Division Three title.

A series of promotions followed, alongside moves between local grounds before settling at Homers Lane, Kingsteignton.

League success came in 1994-95 and again in 1999-00, securing elevation to the Devon League.

## County League Consolidation (2000–2007)

Buckland finished runners-up to Willand Rovers in their debut Devon League campaign and reached the Throgmorton Cup Final a year later.

Steady progress over seven seasons culminated in promotion to the newly formed South West Peninsula League in 2007.

#### The Golden Era (2007-2012)

The Bucks established themselves quickly at Step 6. Following a 14th-place debut, they surged to 3rd the next season before clinching back-to-back league titles in 2009–10 and 2010–11, alongside the Throgmorton Cup.

With ambitions growing, the club met the ground-grading criteria for Step 5 football and were promoted to the Western League in 2012.

#### Western League Years (2012-Present)

Their debut season brought a top-half finish and off-field success with awards for best programme and hospitality. A runners-up finish in 2014–15 remains their highest Western League placing, while the 2016–17 FA Vase saw the Bucks reach the 6th Round.

Further silverware followed in 2017–18 with victory in the Les Phillips Cup. After the passing of long-serving chairman Roy Holmes in 2020 and the disruption of COVID-19, the club restructured as Buckland Athletic FC Ltd, emerging with renewed stability and ambition.

#### A New Era (2021-Present)

Following mid-table finishes after the restart, Dan Hart led the club to a Western League play-off place in 2023–24.

Ahead of 2025–26, a new management team of Matt Cusack and Dan Harrison, supported by Shane Reavey, has taken the reins at Homers Heath, aiming to push Buckland towards long-awaited Step 4 football.
